MONTH EVENTS:

POMC Cars at the Club September 2022

After there was no second Sunday event at the Pretoria Old Motor Club (POMC) in August, the club held a Cars at the Club event on the 11th of September 2022.



There was no specific theme; therefore, cars from all countries and eras could be displayed, but the turnout was lower than expected. However, there were a few interesting cars on display. Before the Japanese manufacturers became popular, American pick-ups were top sellers, especially the Chevrolet 3100 of the 1950's. These have become a rare sight on South African roads but a few are still around. One of them, owned by Jaco Fischer, was bought at the end of 1955 and registered in 1956. It was bought in Windhoek in Namibia but stood on a farm in Carolina for many years before being restored in 1996/7. It is still in an original condition.

In 1955, the MGA was introduced as a replacement for the classic T-Series. It was a completely new and more modern car which shared its mechanical components with the Magnette sedan. The MG club recently held an event at the POMC premises and Ian Greyling's 1958 MGA won a first prize at that event. It was also on display at the POMC event; it took almost four years for this car to be restored to its original condition.



In 1985, Toyota introduced two

models to its then-new Corolla range that were ahead of their time and set new standards in their market segment. The GLi Sprinter and Avante Twincam 16 models had engines with twin overhead camshafts and four valves per cylinder and the former model became South Africa's first Car of the Year in 1986. In the same year the range was facelifted. Pieter Mostert's GLi Avante is one of the facelifted models and was manufactured in 1987. However, he has made a few changes; the exterior colour has been changed, larger brake discs were fitted in the int's system and fitted new camshafts. The front side indicators were changed to those originally fitted to the Nissan Skyline.



The Porsche 944 is a popular car among POMC members and there are several of them in the club. One of them is an import from the United Kingdom. Paul du Plessis has owned his 1984 model for about ten years and it has only done 73 000 miles. His car has not been fitted with the optional power steering.

Johnny Gous is not only a POMC member but he is also a member of the classic car club Van toeka tot nou. One of his classic cars is a 1981 Mercedes-Benz 380 SE, one of the first W 126 models to be manufactured in South Africa. It has two factory-fitted optional extras; an electric sunroof and alloy wheels. Johnny has owned his car, which has not been restored, for two years.



The Mercedes-Benz W 114/115, also known as the New Generation, was on the market from 1968 to 1977, and was a popular model range in South Africa. The 280 and 280 E were added to the range for the 1973 model year and later that year, the W 115, which was the facelifted model, was introduced. It featured ribbed tail lamps, a driver door mirror mounted further forward, head restraints and a four-spoke steering wheel while the front quarterlight windows were omitted. The flagship of that range was the 280 E Automatic. An immaculate version of this increasingly rare model was on display, but it was not possible to chat to the owner.



Pieter Kuhn is another club member who owns a few classic cars and his 1965 Ford Galaxie 500 is on display regularly. However, he added another Galaxie to his collection two months ago. His 1967 model Galaxie LTD is in an immaculate condition even though it has never been restored. It was the last Galaxie on the South African market fitted with the vertical headlamps similar to those of the 1970-72 Ford Fairlane.



The

Toyota Celica was never officially introduced to South Africa, but a few made it to South Africa. One of them was a 1990 Celica GT-Four; a four-wheel drive model based on the version used for the World Rally Championship. Gideon Scheepers has owned this car, which was imported to South Africa from Botswana, for about two years. The previous owner of this car was Mickey Harris.



The next event at the POMC premises will be the display of cars with air-cooled engines on the 2nd of October and The Spring Festival for cars, bikes, trucks and stationary engines on 9 October.

- d'Etat = Volledige beoordeling van die motor, insluitend die enjin en onderstel

- d'Elegance = Buitekant en binnekant, insluitend die kattebak.





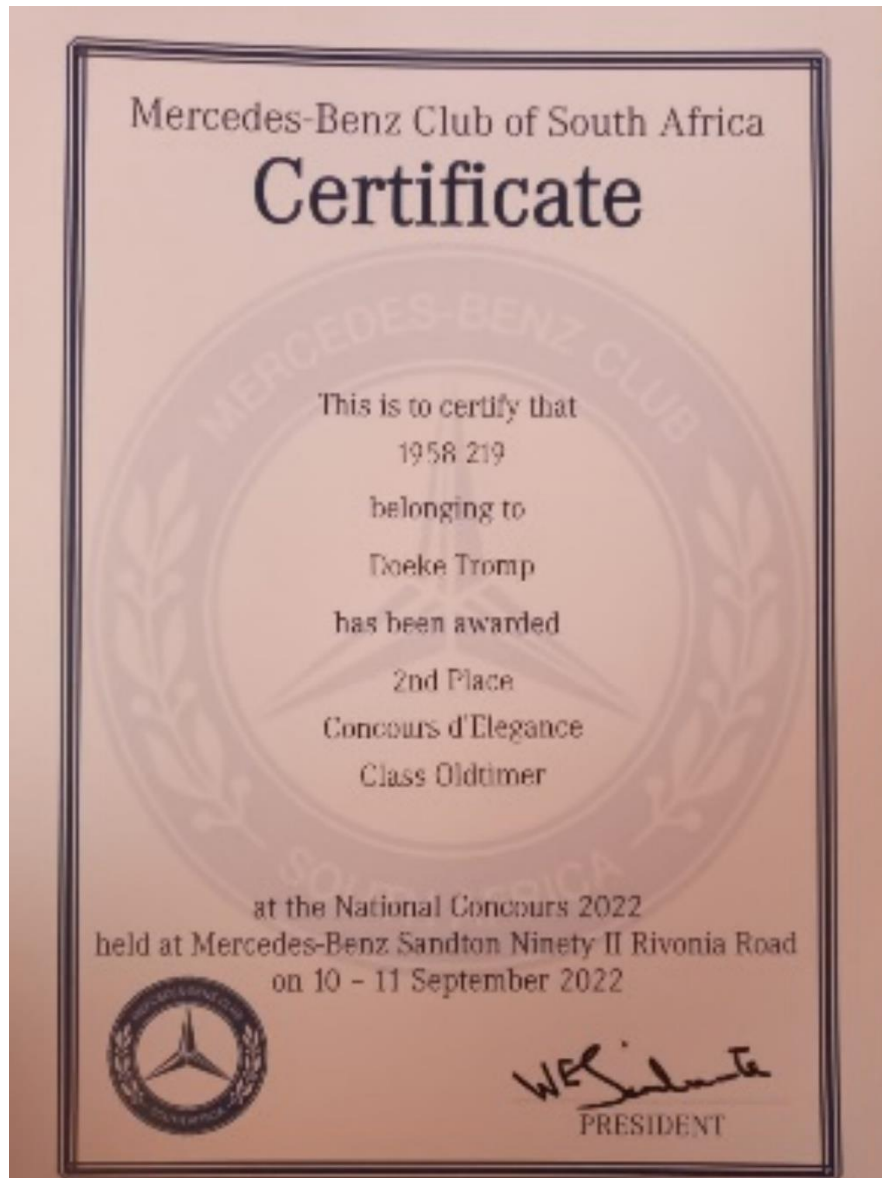
Ek het vir die d'Elegance ingeskryf omdat ek nie geriewe het om my motor se onderstel perfek te kry soos ander nie.

Die Model T Ford Klub van Suid Afrika, die organiseerders van die **TWK Versekering SAVVA Nasionale toer** was baie verras met die aantal inskrywings vir die toer.... Vyf en dertig inskrywings, wat ook ses motorfietse ingesluit het. Die kriteria vir inskrywings was: Motors, vervaardig voor 31 Desember 1930 en motorfietse, vervaardig voor 31 Desember 1936. (DJ Motorfietse)

Die oudste motors wat deelgeneem het was drie 1911 Model T Fords, en die oudste motorfiets was 'n 1925 Indian Scout. Die Indian se baas was Bill Lance.

Met die eerste ligstrale wat Maandagoggend op die dam se water geval het, het ieder en elk besef dat dit 'n dag met GROOT uitdagings gaan wees... Moeder natuur het besluit dat dit 'n dag van reën, wind en baie koue gaan wees!!

Na ontbyt, en die amptelike foto-sessie, is die neuse van die motors/ motofietse in die rigting van Bethulie gerig. By die Kuilsfontein plaasstal is lekker gekuier en is die innerlike ook met iets warmes verstek. Die roete het die deelnemers na die **OU KAR PUB EN GRILL** in Bethulie geneem vir middag-ete. Daar was nog geen verandering in die weersomstandighede nie ... bibber koud en nat. Na baie trappies en moeë bene en 'n baie interessante lesing oor die ontwerp en konstruksie van die dam en sy wal, is ons oppad na Colesberg,



meer spesifiek na die bekende skrootwerf van Piet en Hannes Windpomp! Hier is Model T en Model A onderdele en ander oudhede nog volop te sien tussen al die ander skatte in die skrootwerf.



Na heerlike koffie, boerebeskuit en 'n worsbroodjie en ja, ook 'n vuurtjie om ons weer warm te maak, is ons weer oppad.... Oppad na die baie mooi **Wachbank Lodge**, waai die wind so erg dat dit voel of my Model T Ford stilstaan. By Waschbank Lodge aangekom, word ons verras met ietsie om die koue te verjaag.



Na ongeveer 100 km is ons weer terug by Gariep Forever Resort vir aandete en 'n heerlike kuier-

aand, met die hoop dat Woensdag die perfekte dag vir ons toer sal wees.



Dag drie breek aan en 'n amper perfekte dag wag op ons ... Die tydren-groep se roete neem die deelnemers van die Gariep Forever Resort na Vensterstad oor die D H Steyn brug net voor Bethulie. By Gariep aangekom haas ons na die Bootklub waar ons op 'n "sundowner cruise" gaan ... wat 'n belewenis!!



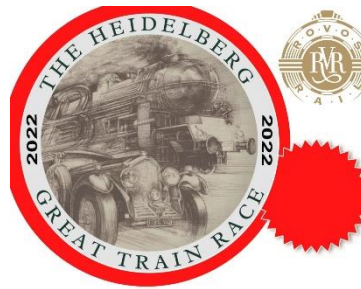

The Heidelberg Great Train race

24 September

Soos baie van ons lede sal weet was dit die Heidelberg "Great train race" op 24 September.

INLEIDING: (vir die van julle wat eintlik net meer wil weet oor die byeenkoms, gaan deur tot by "Die Groot dag")

Chris Van, die organiseerder het my maande voor die tyd al genooi en gevra watter "Pre war" motor ek soentoe kan vat. Hy het Jurjen met sy highwheeler in elk geval ook uitgenooi. Ek het hom daaraan herinner dat Jurjen se highwheeler eintlik 'n replika is en dat dit dalk nie in almal se smaak sal val nie. Maar Chris het aangedring op Jurjen se highwheeler. Ek het aangebied om my 1928 Pontiac na die byeenkoms te vat. Tydens Cars in the Park loop ek Chris toe weer raak en soos baie lede sal weet het ek die jaar met my elektriese highweeler daar rondgery. Toe Chris die highwheeler/perdekar-kruising (baster?) van my sien sê hy vir my dat ek eerder die highwheeler moet vat in plaas van die Pontiac. Ek wys hom toe op die punt dat dit ook eintlik maar 'n replika is, alhoewel die perdekar wat ek verander het na 'n highwheeler wel 'n oorspronklike 1910 model is.



Dus, so het dit begin- ons moes planne maak om ons highwheelers in Heidelberg te kry. Voor Cars in the Park het ek vir 2 dae die Kragdag by Diamondhill met my highwheeler bygewoon en daar is ek toe genooi vir 'n onderhoud oor my highwheeler op Pretoria FM. Nou sal julle dadelik dink wat het dit met die Heidelberg Great Train race te doen. Maar tydens my onderhoud het die aanbieder my gevra hoekom ek my highwheeler elektries gemaak het- en na 'n lang verduideliking sê ek toe onder andere dat ek eerder 'n elektriese highwheeler wou bou (want hulle het bestaan vanaf 1880) as wat ek 'n highwheeler sou bou wat soos 'n motorfiets klink. Dit moet ten minste 'n ou, lae revolusie engine wees. Dit was 'n fout. 'n Groot fout. Want Jurjen se highwheeler het op daardie stadium nog 'n motorfiets engine in gehad. Toe ek dit se besef ek



dadelik ek moes dit nie gesê het nie. Maar dit was op radio. Lewendig. Kon nie “rewind” nie. Die uitlating het Jurjen net daar laat besluit om ’n ouer tipe engine in sy highwheeler in te bou. Meeste highwheelers het “flat twins” of om ’n mooier term te gebruik “air cooled vertically opposed twin cylinder” engines gehad. En Jurjen het 2 sulke engines gehad. Hy het die Maandag dadelik sy motorfiets engine uitgehaal en begin koprap hoe hy die nuwe engine kan inbou. Nou ja, ek moet eintlik ’n artikel skryf oor die Heidelberg Great Train Race skryf, dus ek sal nie in verdere detail ingaan nie. Maar Jurjen het toe sy “flat twin” suksesvol ingebou. Maar tyd vir uitgebreide toetsritte was daar nie.

Intussen sit ek en wonder of die stel batterye (vier “deep cycle” batterye) sal hou vir die afstand wat ons moet ry. Ek was redelik seker dit sou, want ek het tydens Cars in the Park 17 kilometer gery en die dag voor Cars in the Park 14 Kilometer. Die afstand wat ons van die vliegveld na die stasie en terug moes ry was 7 kilometer. Dus, niks om oor bekommerd te wees nie. Maar die Maandag voor die byeenkoms redeneer ek myself in die moeilikheid in- ek gaan tog bele in ’n nuwe stel batterye. Iets wat ek al vir maande oor gesit en peins het. Die plan was om ’n paar los goed te verkoop en dan die batterye te koop. Maar prioriteite verander en ek koop ’n nuwe stel batterye vir R17250. Die kredietkaart moes maar sy werk doen.

Die volgende gedeelte van die storie is die voorbereiding. Ons het gehoor daar is badkamers by die vliegveld en ons besluit om daar vir die nag te kampeer. Die alternatief sou wees dat ons BAIE vroeg sou moes ry om bestyds te wees om 8 uur by die versamelpunt te moet wees met ons ou karre. Ek probeer nou dink wanneer ek vir die laaste keer kampeer het. Ek kan nie eers onthou nie. Maar dit is langer as 10 jaar gelede. En dit is nie meer dieselfde opwinding om te kampeer as wat dit was toe ek nog ’n jong man was nie. Dit verg ook baie beplanning, wat gaan ons alles nodig kry en wat moet ons saamvat. Ek dink volgende keer sal ek waarskynlik maar net eenvoudig baie vroeg ry. Dit is definitief minder moeite. Nog ’n interessante besluit wat Jurjen toe maak is dat hy sy karavaan (vir die wat nie weet nie: Jurjen se highwheeler word gebere in sy karavaan- dit is dus sy garage asook sy sleepwa vir die highwheeler) gaan sleep met sy 1970 Mercedes 508D bus. Hy het al voorheen met die Chevrolet Kommando, asook sy splitscreen Kombi gesleep. Maar die twee karre is nie ideale sleepvoertuie nie. Dus, Jurjen moes toe nou eers ’n “tow bar” aan sy bus prakseer.





Uiteindelik, na al die harde werk en voorbereiding is ons reg om te vertrek, die Vrydagmiddag teen so 1 uur se kant. My Kombi en sleepwa staan in die pad met die highwheeler en ek loop vir oulaas na my huis om die agterdeur te sluit. Terwyl ek terugloop sien ek daar lê water onder my Kombi. Jurjen het dadelik sy overall baadjie aan en kyk waar die lek vandaan kom. Hy vind dit gou genoeg. Op een van die pype wat van die engine na die radiator vorentoe loop. Die water val ongeveer 60cm van die lek op die grond, dus ek sou nie somer daai lek gevind het nie. Jurjen het dadelik alles wat nodig is om die lek reg te maak byderhand en binne 10 minute is ons reg om in die pad te val. Ek gooi toe water in die watertenk. Maar die Kombi het twee watertenks en ek het nooit geweet dat die boonste een heeltemaal vol moet wees nie. Dus, ons trek daar weg, maar die rooi liggie wat my moet waarsku dat die engine oorverhit of dat daar te min water in die



sisteem is bly flikker. In Sunnyside is die Kombi se engine behoorlik warm. Ons wag so 15 minute en kan uiteindelik die prop oopmaak en ons gooi etlike liters water in. Van daar af was alles reg. Ons is op die snelweg en ons begin maar op 'n lae spoed sleep. Ek weet dat die vier batterye wat 38 kilogram elke weeg en wat agter die sleepwa-as is en redelik hoog in die highwheeler is, glad nie goed is vir stabiliteit nie. En vinnig kom ek agter dat my vermoede reg was. Ek kan niks bo 80 kmpu kom nie, dan begin die sleepwa "swing". Hierdie is natuurlik 'n onderwerp waaroor baie mense al debatte gevoer het, maar ek

het na baie jare se geslepery agtergekom dat dit nie goeie raad is om dan meer petrol te gee en die kombinasie te probeer reg trek nie. Glo my, dit werk nie. 'n Mens wil so gou as moontlik op 'n veilige spoed kom waar die kombinasie meer stabiel is. In my geval was dit 65 kmpu. Dus, teen my verwagting in, trek Jurjen met sy ou bus met die karavaan en highwheeler binne onder my uit. Uit ondervinding het ek ook geleer dat 'n kombinasie ook makliker onstabiel raak teen 'n afdraande. Dus, teen die afdraande ry ek 65-70 kmpu. Teen die bulte op 80 kmpu. Nog steeds kry ek Jurjen nie gevang nie. Maar ons het sonder enige verdere voorvalle Heidelberg bereik. Ek gaan nou nie verder uitbrei oor die kampeerdery nie...

Nou goed, dit was dan my inleiding van my storie.





Die Groot dag

Ons het die oggend nog steeds vroeg opgestaan. Ek wou nog my sleepwa (wat dan ook my stalletjie was) op die uitstal terrein sit, so daar was nog 'n paar goedjies om te doen. Intussen het Bob Bouwmeester en sy vrou Ilse by ons aangesluit, ook mooi uitgedos in outydse klere. En met KOFFIE en MUFFINS. Groot muffins. Dus, ons was geholpe met 'n lekker ontbyt. Ons het vertrek na die versamelpunt en as ek reg onthou was daar 42 "pre war" karre wat daar bymekaar gekom het. Eerste keer dat ek so ver op 'n teerpad met my highwheeler ry en met die tiller in my hand teen topspoed verg dit redelike konsentrasie om die kontrepsie in die pad te hou. Eintlik oordryf ek. Die highwheeler met tiller en al ry eintlik baie lekker en gemaklik.



Op pad kon ons die stoomtrein sien staan, reg om met ons die trajek van so 350 meter af te lê. As ek reg onthou het die stoomtrein stiptelik om 8h30 aangekom en ons het langs die stoomtrein met al ons ou karre gery. Wat 'n belewenis. Dan was daar ook nog ou vliegtuie wat intussen oor ons gevlieg het. Ek het verwag ons sou op die platform bly staan om fotos te neem, maar daar word toe vir ons gewys dat ons moet deur ry. Ek het later vir Chris genoem dat dit eintlik my verwagting was om op die platform te bly staan om fotos te neem en volgens Chris was dit die bedoeling, maar êrens het die kommunikasie nie reg deurgekom nie. Op pad terug het mede POMK-lid, Graham Blackbeard, voor gery met sy Bentley, terug na die vliegveld. Ek was verbaas dat ek kon byhou met my elektriese highwheeler. Launch and delivery date for the long-anticipated publication – Kyalami Grand Prix Circuit – 60 Years of Memories announced.

A large format coffee table style book of more than 500 pages covering the history and memories of 60 years of the history of the Kyalami Grand Prix Circuit will be launched at a book signing and hand over at a function on 4 November 2022 at the Kyalami Grand Prix Circuit. This date significantly representing the circuit's 61st Birthday.

The book, which covers the full 60 years of the circuit's history, including both international and local events, contains over 1500 images and 225 special "Kyalami Memories". It is only available, for the first print, on a pre-order basis. Both the Collector's Editions as well as the Publisher's Editions of the book are sold out with limited copies of the Standard Edition still available. The First Print has been limited to only 762 copies made up of 62 Collectors Editions, 200 Publishers Editions and 500 copies of the Standard Edition. A second print run will be announced after the 4 November launch.

This commemorative publication covers 60 years of international and local events hosted at the Circuit and makes use of many, previously unseen, images to illustrate its amazing history. Importantly, it additionally contains personal memories from great racing drivers and riders, officials, photographers, journalists, and numerous other personalities who have played a role in creating 60 Years of Motorsport Memories at this iconic venue.

The world-renowned Kyalami Grand Prix Circuit, situated between the major South African cities of Johannesburg and Pretoria, celebrated its 60th Anniversary in 2021. The first race meeting took place at the then new circuit on 4 November 1961. The Circuit soon established itself as the premier motorsport venue in Southern Africa and became a firm favourite with international and local motor racing legends and their teams.

The first section of the book covers the 60 years of motorsport events staged at Kyalami. The story begins in November 1961 and ends with the 2021 Kyalami 9 Hour held in February 2022. Each year's motorsport activity at the Circuit and nationally, is summarised with the addition of period images and results of the international races and listings of the various South African circuit racing champions. This section of the book covers 120 pages.

The second section of the book details the races held at Kyalami from 1961 until 2022. Many of the hundreds of programme covers for these races are depicted in these 20 pages.

The third section of the book is dedicated to 60 Years of incredible images from numerous well-known local motorsport photographers including Gavin Stapleton, Malcolm Sampson, David Pearson (Motoprint.co.za), Roger Swan, Colin Watling, Woody Rodseth, Keith Doig, Johan Pretorius, Paul Blackburn, Eric Buijs, and Tony Alves. Over 1500 quality images cover various themes and the various formulae and categories that have competed at the circuit over the 60-year period. The images contain detailed captions that cover images taken on track, in the pits and of the competing drivers, riders and teams.

The fourth section of the book covers 60 years of Kyalami Memories. This section contains over 225 special memories received from race drivers, riders, officials, motoring media, photographers, sponsors, marshals, race fans and others that have played a role in the 60 Years of history at the Kyalami Grand Prix Circuit. This section of the book contains 120 pages of memories with over 250 quality images.

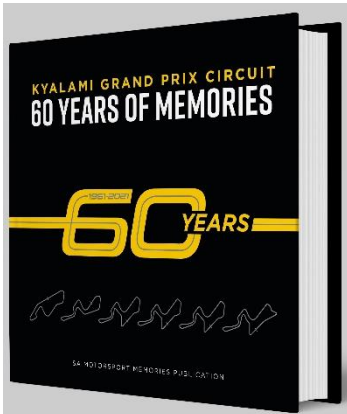

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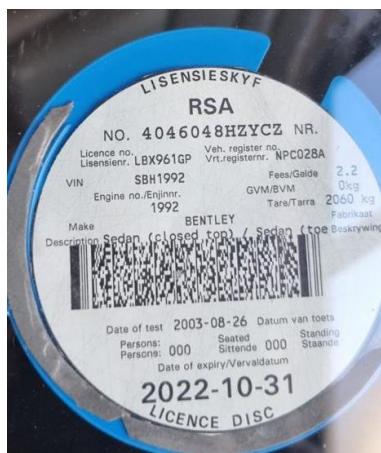
